24th Literary Studies Congress at Ufes LITERATURE IN THE PANDEMIC

Call for Symposia

The Postgraduate Program in Literature at the Federal University of Espírito Santo (UFES) encourages the submission of symposium proposals for the upcoming 24th Literary Studies Congress on the theme "Literature in the Pandemic". The event will take place in Vitória, Brazil (and online) from 8 to 10 November 2022.

We aim to discuss the impacts of Covid-19 on the work of those who teach, research, write, edit, publish and sell literature. The event brings together writers, professors, researchers, students and scholars, in order to favor discussions both on the literary field during the pandemic of the new coronavirus, and on the pandemics of the present and the past as a literary and aesthetic subject, focusing on the theme in different theoretical and methodological perspectives.

Communications will be presented at thematic symposia that will discuss specific topics on literature under pandemic and/or on the pandemic in literature.

The Symposia will be held virtually (via Google Meet). Registrants will receive an email with the link to the event before the settled date.

Guides And Tutorials

The Organizing Committee will host international symposia in an online format.

The symposia will be distributed preferably in the afternoon shift and, if necessary, in the morning shift (Brasilia time/BRT). The distribution of the symposia on days and shifts will be carried out by the Organizing Committee of the event, based on internal organization criteria.

Each symposium must have a minimum of 2 (two) and a maximum of 3 (three) chairs, with a minimum of 1 (one) PhD. The other coordinators can be masters or PhD students. The proposal should include professional biographies of the chairs that highlight their qualifications and track records in the proposed subject area.

Cases in which the same coordinator proposes more than one symposium will not be accepted.

Each symposium, to be included in the final program, must be composed of a minimum of 6 (six) and a maximum of 14 (fourteen) papers.

The symposium proposal, once approved by the Organizing Committee, will be published on the PPGL website, and individual submissions will be forwarded to the chairs for evaluation, through the personal e-mail used for registration. In order to facilitate the selection process, it is important to include in the symposium proposal e-mails of all coordinators, which will be the contact reference for individual submissions.

The proposal must be sent in Portuguese, English or Spanish, in a doc file, including a title and a single paragraph summary, which must briefly present the focus of the symposium's discussion and its aggregating elements. The text must be between 200 and 300 words in Times New Roman font, size 12, single spaced, in standard Word margin, with justified alignment. The title of the

symposium must also be in Times New Roman, size 12, bold, centered, preceding the abstract. After the title, inform the name of the chairs and the institution's acronym, aligned to the right.

No registration fee. Certificates will be provided to the registered participants.

Selected papers will be published in a post-conference book with ISBN.
